



ARENAL OBSERVATORY LODGE & HANGING BRIDGES



Just 30 minutes from La Fortuna town, the only private nature reserve within the Arenal National Park boasts more than 20 kms of private trails in a tropical foothill rainforest and is host to an amazing 400 plus bird species. In addition, you may encounter wildlife such as Spider Monkeys, Howlers Monkeys, Coatis, Brocket Deer, Tamandua Anteaters and Peccaries. Unique to this area are two private suspension/canopy bridges, an impressive canopy tower, a beautiful waterfall, and a new Volcano visitors center with data and photos on the history of the Volcano. The trails are a hotspot for naturalists and hikers alike!

Highlights: Private trails and hanging bridges. Great wildlife. Secluded waterfall. Unique vistas of the volcano and lake Arenal. A state-of-the-art Volcano Museum.

Length: Half day with morning and afternoon departures

Includes: Round trip transportation, local guide, entrance fees

WATERFALL CANYONING & RAPPELING



This is an exhilarating 3-hour experience! Enjoy the opportunity to hike through tropical rainforest in the shadow of Arenal Volcano leading to a series of waterfalls in a pristine canyon. Here, rappel down four waterfalls and one canyon wall. Your guides will secure you into your safety harness and assist you as you descend through the area's enchanting gorges and lush rainforest.

Highlights: Impressive adventure and canyoning exploration in the rainforest. Remote and unique landscape. The most professional guides.

Length: Half day with morning and afternoon departures

Includes: Round trip transportation, local guide, entrance fees, gear as needed

Bring: Multi-sport sandals or tennis shoes, change of clothes and shoes, quick dry clothing



SARAPIQUI WHITEWATER RAFTING



The Sarapiquí River descends from the central mountains into the Caribbean lowlands passing through lush rainforests and farmlands. Just an hour away from la Fortuna, enjoy over 2 hours of rafting along a 15 km section of exciting white-water Class II-III rapid – a guaranteed fun experience! The rafts fit 4 to 6 passengers and guide and are followed by safety kayakers. Lower sections of the river are suitable for families with young children and an upper section of the river is suitable for those looking for more challenging rapids.

Highlights: Best Class III river near Arenal Volcano. Great for wildlife. Perfect combination of nature and adventure! Certified guides. Tropical fruit snacks.

Length: Full day with morning departures

Includes: Round trip transportation, local guide, entrance fees, lunch, gear as needed

Bring: Shorts or swimming suits, sunscreen, walking shoes that can get wet or secure all terrain sandals, change of clothing.



CAÑO NEGRO WILDLIFE REFUGE (RIVER BOAT OR CANOE)



This tour is one of our naturalist guides' favorites for viewing river and rainforest wildlife! Located two hours away from la Fortuna the Caño Negro National Wildlife Refuge and Río Frío combine wetlands and riparian forest are host to water birds, iguanas, caimans, monkeys, sloths, river turtles and many forest bird species. Enjoy a 3-hour covered river boat safari or opt to canoe downriver and boat back up, in the company of a naturalist guide who will point out wildlife and explain the area's ecology.

Highlights: Unique wildlife boat or canoe tour on a tropical river. One of best rivers to find wild animals in Costa Rica.

Length: Full day with morning departures

Includes: Round trip transportation, local guide, entrance fees, lunch, gear as needed

Bring: Binoculars, walking shoes or all terrain sandals, sun block, hat, and camera



PEÑAS BLANCAS RIVER FLOAT TRIP / CANOE ADVENTURE



Just a 30-minute drive from la Fortuna, the lower section of the Peñas Blancas River is calm and ideal for a relaxing two-hour river float trip to admire river and adjacent rain forest habitat. You will likely encounter iguanas, monkeys, river birds, basilisk lizards and other creatures of these tropical habitats. This is an ideal introduction to the wonders of the rainforest!

Highlights: Great for families and wildlife viewing. Expert naturalist guides.

Length: Half day with morning and afternoon departures

Includes: Round trip transportation, local guide, entrance fees, gear as needed

Bring: Binoculars, all terrain sandals, sun block, hat, camera, and change of clothes.









Enjoy a two-and-a-half-hour horseback ride on a private cattle farm along the slopes of the Volcano. You will pass through pristine creeks, lush primary forest, and pasture lands. Don't mind the sheep, horses and cattle you see along the way!

Spectacular views of the volcano make wonderful pictures!

Highlights: Private access to remote farms near the Volcano. Amazing views and great photo ops. Adventure experience. No crowds or cars.

Length: Half day with morning and afternoon departures

Includes: Round trip transportation, local guide, entrance fees, gear as needed

Bring: Long pants, long sleeved shirt, insect repellent, sunscreen and sunglasses, walking shoes (no sandals), and camera.



The two-hour/5 km Coladas Trail begins off the main road to the park entrance and crosses an open area before rapidly reverting to forest in front of the west flank of Arenal Volcano. It leads to a blocky lava flow that crushed its way through the area in 1992. End your active day where the steaming waters of a nearby river tumble from the lava fields and cascade. Enjoy and relax at a thermals resort that boasts natural mineral pools and hot springs set in exotic gardens.

Highlights: Experience walking on lava rocks. Photo ops of amazing lookouts. Great tour to look for birds and animals. Relaxing in world class thermals!

Length: Half day with morning and afternoon departures

Includes: Round trip transportation, local guide, entrance fees

Bring: Binoculars, walking shoes, bottle of water, insect repellent, sun block, raincoat, hat, camera, swimming suit, sandals.

BALSA WHITEWATER RAFTING



Located only 45 minutes from La Fortuna, the Rio Balsa offers 10 kms of beautiful Class II-III whitewater action. Along the river you can view birds, rainforest wildlife, and the majestic Arenal Volcano. This whitewater experience is great for beginners.

Highlights: Great for beginners. Perfect combination of rafting, nature, and adventure! Certified guides.

Length: Full day with morning departures

Includes: Round trip transportation, local guide, entrance fees, lunch, gear as needed

Bring: Shorts or swimsuit, sunscreen, walking shoes that can get wet or a secure all terrain sandals, change of clothing.





DANAUS ECOCENTER



This small biological reserve, 15 minutes east of the town of La Fortuna, is a model of conservation. Once open farmland, this reserve has been allowed to revert to forest and now teems with wildlife. A main 1.5-hour trail winds through the forest where visitors can see a number of the 154 bird species recorded here, including honey-creepers, euphonias, tanagers & toucans. Several slow-moving sloths and other curious creatures live here too.

Highlights: Butterfly Garden with colorful species. Great chances to see poison frogs, sloths, and many birds! A true conservation project. Maleku Indian handmade crafts.

Length: Half day with morning and afternoon departures

Includes: Round trip transportation, local guide, entrance fees

Bring: Binoculars, walking shoes, water, insect repellent, sun block, raincoat, hat, and

camera

SLOTH TERRITORY



Arenal area is well known for its nature and wildlife, including the two different sloth species living in Costa Rica. During this 3-hour tour our main goal is to find as many sloths as possible. On the search for these beautiful animals our knowledgeable guide will drive you around la Fortuna's beautiful spotting areas for more wildlife such as toucans, poison dart frogs, hummingbirds, iguanas, and monkeys!

Highlights: Great chances to find the two species of sloths in the wild! Expert naturalist guides. Great experience for birdwatching. All hot spot sites for sloths are near la Fortuna.

Length: Half day with morning and afternoon departures

Includes: Round trip transportation, local guide, entrance fees

Bring: Binoculars, walking shoes, insect repellent, sun block, raincoat, hat, and camera





Highlights: Biking along secluded secondary roads. Great opportunities to see wildlife and take in the rural countryside.

ATV TOUR



After a scenic short drive to a private farm located close to Arenal Volcano National Park, your adventure begins. Make sure you dress for success on this excursion by choosing clothing you can get dirty. It's sure to be a wild 3-hour ride, and the rainforest trails are often muddy. After safety talk, you will have time to become comfortable on your 4 x 4 with a few practice runs. Once you're ready, we roll out for a wild adventure through gorgeous Costa Rican rainforests, rolling foothills and lush backcountry.

Highlights: Explore little-known and muddy trails and roads in Arenal area. Ultimate adventure experience!

Length: Half day with morning and afternoon departures

Includes: Round trip transportation, local guide, entrance fees, equipment

Bring: Tennis shoes (no flip flops, sandals, or open-toed shoes), camera, sunscreen, comfortable clothing you can get dirty, raingear, insect repellent

Restrictions: ATV drivers must be 16 years of age or older with a valid driver's license. No seniors over 65 years old and no children under 12 years old. Unlicensed participants and children under 16 must ride as passengers.





CAMPESINO EXPERIENCE



Enjoy a taste of Costa Rica! Immersed in the warm and natural habitat facing the Arenal Volcano and surrounded by rivers and rainforests, we are welcomed to an organic orchard run by a local family.
