

### **ABOUT SAN JOSÉ**

The city of San José is the national capital and thriving economic center of Costa Rica. Today the easy-to-explore city is **undergoing a renaissance** with modern high-rise buildings emerging, like the Legislative Assembly Building and the Costa Rica Central Bank's office, and the creation of the Torres River nature-urban walking path—a serene nature walk in the heart of the city. Yet it retains much of its past **multicultural heritage** evident in the meticulously restored **elegant buildings**, historical statues, and parks. Its many international restaurants offer excellent cuisine, and its theaters host numerous concerts and performances. Nightlife abounds in clubs with dancing to salsa, merengue, and even rock music! San José has several **terrific museums**, including The National Museum, Gold Museum, and Jade Museum. All have excellent exhibits, and the latter two feature artworks by prehistoric indigenous people.

### SAN JOSÉ CITY TOUR

SAN JOSÉ

Spend a half day exploring San José with your private guide. Visit the "Jewel of San José," the National Theatre—a masterpiece in art and architecture built by Costa Ricans and completed in 1897. Take your pick to peruse the Jade, Gold, or National Museum. Browse the aisles and select mementos at the Central Market, a city locale steeped in Costa Rican cultural heritage and traditions. Visit the Metropolitan Cathedral, the Old Train Station, the National Liquor Factory, the Legislative Assembly Building, and the Metallic Building. Beautiful parks and various other sites of interest will be interspersed on this tour—an excellent introduction to the capital city with focus on its economy, culture, politics, religion, and general current events.

# MUSEO DE ORO

SAN JOSÉ

Costa Rica's Pre-Columbian Gold Museum boasts one of the largest collections of gold artifacts in Latin America. These ancient objects chronicle the history of the tribal peoples and civilizations that once inhabited the country. Some of these artifacts are more than 1.500 years old, and the collections on display at the museum reveal Costa Rica's fascinating past. You will enjoy a fascinating variety of temporary and permanent exhibitions.

### **MUSEO DE JADE**

SAN JOSÉ

The Jade Museum in downtown San José is a true definition of modern architecture and a must visit if you have extra time in the city. Home to the largest collection of pre-Columbian iade in the world, the museum's four floors explore the history of jade as a weapon, trading tool, and finally adornment. In addition, you will find many objects made of clay, stone, and other materials used by Costa Rican native tribes

**Hours:** 9 am to 4:30 pm. Monday to Sunday

### MUSEO NACIONAL SAN JOSÉ

The National Museum was established at the end of the 19th century, in what was known as the Bellavista Barracks-a weapons warehouse and place of military instruction for recruits, to train in tactics and weapons. In 1948, Costa Rica abolished it's army (one of the few countries in the world without one) and the museum was born. It harbors significant collections of natural history and archeology. This museum is an excellent introduction to Costa Rica's ancient cultural legacy.

# TOUCAN RESCUE RANCH + SANCTUARY

SAN JOSECITO

Located near San José, the Toucan Rescue Ranch Sanctuary is a nonprofit organization that provides top-notch treatment and care while it rescues and rehabilitates a variety of wildlife in need of a second chance. During an educational walk, the knowledgeable and personable guides will share fun facts about each species. ### DOKA COFFEE FARM + POÁS VOLCANO

PNÁS VNICANO NATIONAL PARK

Start your day with a morning visit to Doka Coffee Estate—one of the most famous coffee farms in Costa Rica. Enjoy a tasty breakfast with a cup of high-quality coffee then join your expert guide to learn about harvesting and best practices to process the golden bean! After, visit the Poás Volcano National Park. With a summit of 2,708 meters, Poás has an active crater (one of the largest in the world!) with steam and fumaroles visible on clear days from a specially made refuge. The park is home to resident birds like the Resplendent Quetzal, the Fiery-throated Hummingbird and the Sooty Thrush.

**Highlights:** One of the best coffee learning and tasting experiences and an active volcano to discover! Makes the perfect combination of cultural and nature activities in Costa Rica!

# SARAPIQUÍ WHITE WATER RAFTING

SARAPIQUÍ

The Sarapiquí River descends from the central mountains into the Caribbean lowlands passing through lush rainforests and farmlands. Just an hour away from La Fortuna, enjoy over 2 hours of rafting along a 15 km section of exciting white-water Class II-III rapid—a guaranteed fun experience! The rafts fit 4 to 6 passengers and guide and are followed by safety kayakers. Lower sections of the river are suitable for families and an upper section of the river is suitable for those looking for more challenging rapids.

**Highlights:** Best Class III River near San José. Great for wildlife. Perfect combination of nature and adventure! Certified guides. Tropical fruit snacks.

### IRAZÚ VOLCANO NATIONAL PARK

IRAZÚ VOLCANO NATIONAL PARK

The Irazú Volcano National Park has several craters, two of which are the principal attractions. The larger crater is 275-meters deep with a blue/green lake, providing visitors an amazing sight. On a clear day, the Pacific Ocean and Caribbean Sea are visible. At the 3,432-meter summit of Irazú, the landscape flourishes with paramo like vegetation comprised of small flowering shrubs and dwarf trees. Nearby, an immaculate montane oak forest dominates the landscape. Animals like coatis are seen on occasion, and regularly you will find birds like the volcano junco and the volcano hummingbird—one of the smallest bird species in Costa Rica! There are several trails to explore, the most popular one leads to the top of the volcano.

**Highlights:** Spectacular views on clear days of the crater and nearby cordilleras. Great habitat for hummingbirds and other endemic bird species.

Length: Half day, morning departures

### LA PAZ WATERFALLS + GARDENS

SARAPIOUÍ

Only an hour's drive from San José, La Paz Waterfall Gardens hosts many exhibits including hummingbird gardens, a butterfly garden, and a frog exhibit—it is the largest animal sanctuary in Costa Rica. An excellent trail system will lead you up close to view five spectacular waterfalls in the rainforest. Their mission is to preserve and protect the natural environment of the area for the education, entertainment, and enjoyment of all ages.

Highlights: Enjoy nature activities and wildlife at the famous La Paz Waterfall Gardens Nature Park! An excellent trail system brings you up close to five spectacular waterfalls in the cloud forest!

### **ARTISAN COFFEE TOUR**

SAN MARCO DE TARRAZÚ

Tierra Amiga is a beautiful coffee farm in San Marco de Tarrazú, just an hour and a half from San José. Owned and operated by Lucidia, Minor, and their young daughter Ruth, this is an ecological farm where everything is produced organically. The 80-year-old wooden home on the property is where Minor was born and now Ruth is following in her father's footsteps. This lovely family will share the coffee process from seed to cup—ending with tasting the delicious fresh brew! Lunch will be enjoyed on the patio of a beautiful ranch. An experience to immerse yourself in the culture—100% Costa Rican!

**Highlights:** Learn about coffee, take in spectacular views of the surrounding mountains, and meet local people!

The property is also home to nature trails and beautiful birding gardens. We love to include this lunch stop en-route north from San José—delicioso!

### ARENAL VOLCANO + HOT SPRINGS

**LA FORTUNA** 

In north-central Costa Rica, near the town of La Fortuna, the picture-perfect Arenal Volcano rises majestically above the surrounding lowland plains. The area offers natural beauty and fantastic wildlife. En route to Arenal, you will stop at the famous town of Sarchí, known as the birthplace of Costa Rica's Artisans—a great chance to appreciate many of the arts, crafts, and souvenirs. Also, you will see the world's largest oxcart, according to the Guinness Book. Continue through a diverse agricultural landscape, including pineapple, mango, and plantain farms, ornamental plants, fields, and even cattle ranches before arriving in the small town of La Fortuna. Enjoy lunch at a cozy restaurant with a magnificent view of the volcano before a chance to relax at one of the best hot springs in the area. To top off a great day, a wonderful dinner will be served with a great view of the volcano before returning to San José. If the weather permits, you will have one more opportunity to look at the classically shaped volcano.

**Highlights:** Enjoy a scenic drive to La Fortuna. An excellent chance to see a classically shaped volcano. Discover the world's largest oxcart! Soak in hot springs.

# AN AUTHENTIC RAINFOREST EXPERIENCE

SARAPIOUÍ

On this boat tour, you observe the exuberant tropical flora and fauna of the majestic and historic Sarapiquí River. You can spot monkeys, iguanas, crocodiles, lazy sloths, river otters, and caimans, among other creatures in their natural habitat, as well as a great diversity of colorful birds. The boats are comfortable and equipped with quiet motors and the experienced captains will be on the look-out for wildlife sightings for you! Continue with a walk on the private trails of Selva Verde Eco Lodge—heaven for nature enthusiasts. Following a tasty lunch, stop for a gondola ride through the tree canopy on the famous Rainforest Aerial Tram. For adventure seekers, a zip line is available if you prefer.

**Highlights:** A boat safari through tropical rainforest, walk private trails, and take an aerial tram ride through the treetops to enjoy nature and abundant wildlife.

Carried securely by a system of zip lines, you will soar weightlessly through the expanse of virgin forest grounds and find yourself up-close-and-personal with the habitats of Costa Rica's unique cloud forest wildlife. The San Luis Canopy Tour also presents the Elevator, an exciting feature that securely lifts visitors high above the forest canopy, granting a paramount view of the surrounding area. San Luis Canopy Tour ensures safety as a keystone principle: they take pride in their credentials and confidently guarantee that this tour is among the most professional, informative, and enjoyable in Costa Rica. San Luis Canopy has 12 different zip lines and 18 platforms, plus their famous "Tarzan Swing Trails" and "Fly like Superman."

### WINE TASTING IN THE CLOUD FOREST

**COPEY DE DOTA** 

Copey Estate Winery is the first and only commercial winery in Costa Rica and Central America and the first and only liqueur producer from the famous Golden Berry (considered a superfood). It is located in a unique place (Copey de Dota), practically in the center of Costa Rica, at an altitude of 2300 meters—an area that enjoys a temperate climate and high solar radiation during most of the year, which is a perfect combination that enhances incredible flavors in the fruits. This "Wine + Golden Rush" experience gives you a tour around the terroir that lends the wines an unparalleled flavor, ending with a tasting of four wines and two different ways to drink the Golden Rush liqueur with its pairing.

**Highlights:** One of the first Costa Rican wines produced in the cloud forest belt as well as the Golden Rush, a drink made of the famous uchuva or goldenberry. Beautiful views! **Length:** Full day, morning departures
